GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

1. Applicant must intend to use the funds while enrolled at an accredited school.
2. Completed applications must be received in the church office by the stated deadline. Late applications will not be forwarded to the Board of Trustees.
3. Anyone may apply. The selection process gives first priority to graduating high school seniors, and takes into consideration such factors as grade point and class rank, school and community work, and church involvement.

Priority will be given to:

- Members of St. Stephen's Lutheran Church
- Legacy candidates (i.e. children or grandchildren of congregational members)
- Members of other ELCA congregations
- Members of other denominational affiliation
- All other completed applications

4. High School Applicants must submit their GPA and academic information via their guidance counselor or school office; college applicants must submit a transcript with their application.
